

St Ann's Uniform Policy



St Ann's requires students to maintain a high standard of dress and grooming in order to;

- Foster a sense of school community,
- Increase a sense of belonging,
- Promote health and safety and,
- Encourage respect for self and school.

Students from the St Ann's community are enrolled on the understanding that both parents and students appreciate and support the school's uniform policy. All students are expected to wear full, correct uniform to and from the school and on other occasions as required. When in public, students must wear the full uniform, not parts of the uniform mixed with other clothing.

In the rare event that a student is unable to wear the full correct uniform, parents/ carers should contact the school to explain the circumstances. Parents/ carers will be advised of any uniform breach and reminded of the school uniform policy immediately through either a phone call or email. The uniform should be fixed by the following school day. In severe cases a conversation with the school leadership team may be necessary to support an appropriate course of action.

Sports Uniform

All Year 1 to 6 Students

- St Ann's sports shirt (predominately red sports shirt with school logo embroidered),
- St Ann's black unisex shorts with school name embroidered,
- Black leather shoes,
- St Ann's school socks (white socks with red and green stripes around top),
- St Ann's black school hat with school logo – reversible with sports house colour on the inside.

All Prep Students

- St Ann's Prep sports shirt (predominately green sports shirt with school logo embroidered),
- St Ann's black unisex shorts with school name embroidered,
- Black leather shoes (velcro is encouraged),
- St Ann's school socks (white socks with red and green stripes around top),
- St Ann's black school hat with school logo – reversible with sports house colour on inside.

Winter Uniform

All Prep to Year 6 Students

- St Ann's red tracksuit jumper,
- St Ann's black tracksuit pants,
- If wearing tights/leggings/stockings they should be black.
- St Ann's uniform is to be worn under the jumper.

School Bag - All Prep to Year 6 Students

- St Ann's school bag (black with school logo printed) is compulsory and must be used to and from school.

Hair and Grooming

- Hair must be clean and groomed.
- Hair should be kept neat and tidy.
- Hair longer than collar length must be worn tied back/ up with a green or red hair accessory.
- Extreme hairstyles which draw attention to the student are not accepted and will not be permitted in any form.
- Colour: Hair must be as close as possible to the student's natural colour. Coloured hair which distracts from the natural look of an individual's hair is not permitted in any form.
- Inappropriate hair colour or hair styles will need to be changed within an agreed time.
- Optional hair accessories for students include headbands, scrunchies, hair ties and ribbons. These must be in school colours (either black, yellow, green or red).
- Cultural or religious hairstyles must be discussed and approved by the leadership team.

Jewellery and Make-Up

- Fingernail polish and make up are not to be worn to school.
- Students may wear one set of small studs or sleepers. Choices include small plain silver, rose gold, gold or stones.
- A Christian religious symbol on a chain or necklace can be worn. Both symbol and chain/necklace are to be conservative.
- No decorative jewellery.
- A digital or analogue watch, which is not a toy, may be worn.
- Other cultural or religious jewellery must be approved by the leadership team.

Sun-Safe

- A sun-safe policy is observed.
- Regulation school hats are compulsory and available through our uniform supplier.
- Students must bring their school hat to school every day and wear it when working/playing outside. Parents/ carers should encourage students to wear their hat to and from school.
- If a student does not have a hat they will be required to play in the Hall.
- If a student does not have a hat for outside lessons, a spare hat will be worn.
